Renew Wellbeing - A café style space from 9.30am on Thursday mornings that is established around a quiet space with a rhythm of prayer; a place to belong, share hobbies, learn new skills and connect with others.



Renew Lite Lunch - A shared lunch at minimal price, for those who are feeling shut in and isolated that follows on directly from our Renew Wellbeing sessions on Thursdays at noon. Spaces are limited and should be booked in advance. This is an invitation only event. (If you know someone who might benefit from attending, please let us know).



Renew Mini Sparklers - A group for parents with children aged 0-2 years, at 9.30am on Tuesday mornings (term time).



Stroke Club* - Open to anyone who has suffered from a stroke or has restricting heart condition and who does not require nursing type care during club activities. It is run by volunteers (with DBS clearance). Stroke Club runs **fortnightly at 9.45am on Wednesday mornings** (see Church calendar online for dates).



KnitWits - A group which meets on a monthly basis to knit squares to make baby blankets for the Ivy Street Family Centre in Hoxton or blankets for Watford General Hospital.
